

**DIRECTIONS TO
SILVER CREEK PRESERVE**

To reach Silver Creek Preserve from the west, take Highway 20 east of its intersection with Highway 75 seven miles and turn south at the Silver Creek Preserve highway sign. Follow this road to the Visitor Center. To reach Silver Creek Preserve from the east, take Highway 20 west from Picabo four miles and turn south at the Silver Creek Preserve highway sign

Visitors are required to sign in at the Visitors Center each day they enter the preserve. Please! ... walking or boat access only; no pets, bikes, motorized vehicles, overnight camping, or fires are allowed.

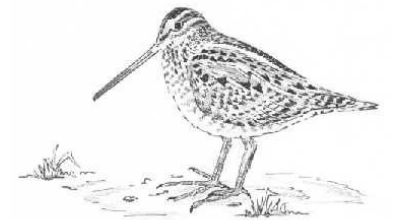

Common Snipe

Silver Creek Preserve protects one of the last intact examples of a high desert cold-spring ecosystem in the western U.S. Silver Creek's spectacular habitat diversity, including shrub land, riparian forest, and wetlands, provides cover and food for over 150 species of birds. The creek is formed entirely by springs from an aquifer that originated along the Big Wood River to the north of the Preserve. Silver Creek's water temperature remains relatively constant (50-60 degrees F). Much of the water is free of ice even during the coldest months making the preserve an oasis for wildlife throughout the year. Please enjoy your visit!
